ENVIRONMENTAL BEST PRACTICE FOR DIVERS

AS AN OPERATOR THAT CARES ABOUT PROTECTING OUR FRAGILE MARINE ECOSYSTEMS, WE ASK ALL OUR CUSTOMERS TO HELP PROTECT MARINE LIFE BY FOLLOWING BEST PRACTICES WHEN DIVING:

DO

Listen carefully to the environmental briefing and follow your guide's instructions

Shoot photos without touching or disturbing the environment

Avoid stirring up sediment by keeping your fins up

Practise good buoyancy control and advanced finning techniques

Ensure equipment is secured and does not dangle or drag over reefs

Respect marine life and give all animals plenty of space

Collect trash if it is safe to do so and there is no marine life living in it

Stay high and clear of the reef

Use reef-safe sunscreen before going in the ocean

DON'T

Do not take marine life - dead or alive - it may be illegal

Do not touch, chase, harass, spear or capture marine life

Do not wear gloves

Do not feed the fish

Do not litter

Do not break laws

Do not touch, kick, kneel or lie on coral

Do not place cameras on the reef or move marine life to get a better photo

Do not stir the sediment
